1. Leader of the SNCC. A current member of the House of Representatives from Georgia. (**john lewis**)
4. President of Morehouse College. Learned non-violence from Gandhi and taught it to Martin Luther King. (**benjamin mays**)
6. Refused to give up her seat on a Montgomery bus sparking the boycott that lasted for over a year. (**rosa parks**)
9. Helped to write the Civil Rights Act. Was assassinated before it was passed. (**john f kennedy**)
10. This industry has grown drastically in modern Georgia. We are currently third behind California and New York. (**filming**)
12. First African American HOR member from Georgia since Reconstruction. Also served as US Ambassador to the United Nations. (**andrew young**)
13. This group was created by MLK and made up a ministers. They lead many marches during the Civil Rights Movement. (**sclc**)
21. This protest was to urge for the passing of the Civil Rights Act. Led by MLK and the SCLC. 'I Have A Dream' (**march on washington**)
23. A march lead in Alabama to fight for voting rights. Protesters were beaten by state police. (**selma**)
24. This student-lead group was known for protesting though sit-ins. Led by John Lewis. (**sncc**)
25. Lead by John Sibley to investigate how Georgians felt about school integration. Ruled each school system could choose. (**sibley commission**)
26. Bringing the races back together. Lester Maddox closed his restaurant rather than do this. (**integration**)
27. Only president to be born in Georgia. Created Habitat for Humanity after his time as president. (**jimmy carter**)
29. Governor known for closing his restaurant rather than integrating. Then hired more blacks to g-ment jobs than anyone before (**lester maddox**)
30. First African American male to attend UGA in 1961. (**hamilton holmes**)

2. Took over for JFK after he was killed. Signed the Civil Rights Act in 1964. (**lyndon b johnson**)
3. This project is currently ongoing to deepen the Savannah port allowing for ships to bring in 3 times the amount of cargo. (**shep**)
5. Passed by LBJ after the March on Washington. Ended all types of segregation across America. (**civil rights act**)
7. The event that came to Atlanta in 1996. Brought tourism, jobs and major growth to the city. (**olympics**)
8. Unsuccessful movement in Georgia to end all segregation at once. Considered a failure by MLK and John Lewis. (**albany movement**)
11. Georgia's protest response to Brown v Board by adding the confederate battle flag. (**1956 state flag**)
14. Passed after the Selma March. Got rid of all types of disfranchisement for voting. (**voting rights act**)
15. The court case that allowed segregation based on 'separate but equal.' Overturned by Brown V Board. (**plessey vs ferguson**)
16. The method used by Gandhi and taught to Martin Luther King by Benjamin Mays. (**nonviolence**)
17. First black mayor of Atlanta. Expanded the airport during his time as mayor. (**maynard jackson**)
18. First female African American to attend the University of Georgia in 1961. (**charlayne hunter**)
19. This court case overturned Plessey V Ferguson and said that all schools had to integrate 'with all deliberate speed.' (**brown vs board**)
20. The movement in Montgomery to not use the city buses after Rosa Parks' arrest. Lead to the desegregation of public transport. (**bus boycott**)
22. This industry is all about bringing people to the state. Either visit the large cities, mountains, or coastline. (**tourism**)
28. Major Civil Rights leader in the Bus Boycott and the Albany Movement. Known for his 'I Have A Dream' speech. (**mlk**)
