- 5.** The city planned around open squares. Established on Yamacraw Bluff. (**savannah**)
- 10.** Crops grown to sell and make money. EX: cotton, tobacco (**cash crop**)
- 11.** Where the highland Scots settled in Georgia. (**darien**)
- 13.** Importing less than you export. (**mercantilism**)
- 16.** Planted by every family in Georgia in hopes of attracting silk worms. (**mulberry trees**)
- 17.** A reason for anger from many of the colonists. This was banned along with slavery and buying and selling of land. (**alcohol**)
- 18.** Appointed by King George to rule Georgia during the Royal Period. There were three of them. (**royal governor**)
- 22.** A group recruited by Oglethorpe to come to Georgia and help defend the colony from the Spanish. (**highland scots**)
- 23.** The original settlement of the Salzburgers. (**ebenezer**)
- 25.** The British colony which Georgia was created to defend. (**south carolina**)
- 26.** A friend of James Oglethorpe who died in a debtor's prison. (**robert castell**)
- 27.** The final Royal Governor. Promoted cash crops and slavery in the Royal colony. (**james wright**)
- 29.** A group of German Protestants who were kicked out of Austria by the Catholics. Came to Georgia for religious freedom. (**salzburgers**)
- 30.** The boat that brought the 114 original settlers to Georgia in 1733. (**ship ann**)

- 1.** Leader of the Yamacraw Indians who befriended James Oglethorpe. (**tomochichi**)
- 2.** The first Royal governor chosen by King George. Created a bicameral legislature in which common people could have a say. (**john reynolds**)
- 3.** The religious group not allowed in Colonial Georgia during the trustee period. (**catholics**)
- 4.** The Indian group in Georgia when Ship Ann arrived. (**yamacraw**)
- 6.** Two houses in legislation. Introduced in Royal Georgia. (**bicameral**)
- 7.** Granted the Charter for Georgia to 21 trustees in 1732. (**king george**)
- 8.** A woman of mixed heritage who helped create a peaceful environment by interpreting for Oglethorpe and Tomochichi. (**mary musgrove**)
- 9.** The acronym for the crops which were to be produced in the Georgia colony. Most of them were unsuccessful. (**wrist**)
- 12.** The only trustee who traveled to the colony of Georgia. (**james oglethorpe**)
- 14.** The place where Ship Ann landed to establish the settlement of Savannah. (**yamacraw bluff**)
- 15.** James Oglethorpe's reason for creating the Georgia colony. Was unsuccessful when no debtors were brought to Georgia. (**philanthropy**)
- 19.** Not permitted in the colony until 1750. A cause for discontent among the colonists. (**slavery**)
- 20.** People who complained about no slavery, no alcohol, and no buying and selling land. (**malcontents**)
- 21.** Oglethorpe tried to capture this Spanish settlement during the War of Jenkins Ear. (**st augustine**)
- 24.** The country that created the first settlement in Georgia. (**england**)
- 28.** Districts in the settlement of Savannah designed around open squares. Public buildings and houses would surround the square. (**wards**)
