5. A small beetle that feeds on cotton. Lead to an economic downturn in Georgia. (**boll weevil**)
6. Not choosing sides in a conflict. (**neutrality**)
8. the movement of blacks and poor whites from the South to Northern industrial cities in search of jobs. (**great migration**)
10. Provided electricity to rural areas. (**rea**)
11. Served four terms as governor. Was opposed to the New Deal programs and also was against the integration of major universities. (**eugene talmadge**)
12. A disease which eventually restricted FDR to a wheelchair. (**polio**)
16. A New Deal program which created benefits for the disabled and elderly. (**ssa**)
17. A lack of water due to little or no rainfall. A major cause of Georgia's depression. (**drought**)
19. Helped people regain trust in the American Banking system. Provided insurance on deposits in banks. (**fdic**)
21. Gave jobs to unemployed men working on service projects. Men were paid \$30 a month. (**ccc**)
23. A secret message sent from Germany trying to persuade Mexico to invade the US. (**zimmerman telegram**)
24. The belief by most politicians that the economy would fix itself without government interventions. (**laissez faire**)
26. Consisted of France, Great Britain, Russia and the United States. Joined forces in defense of Serbia. (**allied powers**)
27. a time of prosperity in America including a growth in Jazz and Blues music. (**roaring 20s**)
28. paid farmers to lower crop production. Lead to the end of sharecropping and tenant farming and also sparked the Great Migration. (**aaa**)

9. Was the president at the beginning of the Great Depression. Was criticized for his Laissez Faire attitude. (**herbert hoover**)
13. Crashed on October 29, 1929 and lead to widespread chaos due to major investment losses. (**stock market**)
14. Assassinated by Serbian Nationalists which sparked the alliance system in Europe. (**archduke ferdinand**)
15. where FDR came in Georgia for polio treatment. (**warm springs**)
18. Homeless towns during the Great Depression. (**hoovervilles**)
20. Georgians' effort to increase the soldiers food supply. (**victory gardens**)
22. Military camp located in Columbus. Known for being the largest infantry training camp in America. (**camp benning**)
