8. An act by the Sons of Liberty to protest the Tea Act. (**boston tea party**)
10. The document which official broke American ties with Great Britain. (**doi**)
11. The first tax imposed on the colonists due to the war debt of Great Britain. (**stamp act**)
13. A part of the Intolerable acts which stated that colonists must house and feed a British soldier at their own expense. (**quartering act**)
14. The only known African American soldier in the Battle of Kettle Creek. (**austin dabney**)
16. Created at the 2nd Continental Congress and lead by George Washington. (**continental army**)
17. A plan that national representatives in congress should be equal from each state. (**new jersey plan**)
18. Imposed on the colonists after the French and Indian War due to war debt. (**taxes**)
19. The first written plan of government in America. (**articles of confederation**)
21. The first plan of government in the state of Georgia. (**rules and regulations**)
24. A group which was created to oppose the Stamp Act. Called the Liberty Boys in Georgia. (**sons of liberty**)
25. The signer of the US Constitution from Georgia not named William Few. (**abraham baldwin**)
27. The last battle of the Revolutionary War. (**yorktown**)
28. Only one house in the legislative branch. This proved to be a weakness of the GA Constitution of 1777. (**unicameral**)
29. The 2nd Provincial Congress was held at Tondee's Tavern in this city. (**savannah**)
30. Known as a Revolutionary War hero due to her bravery. Famous for killing Tories during the war. (**nancy hart**)
